CHEqI is partnering with the [RED Alliance | Reaching to End Disparities](#), which aims to eliminate late-stage breast cancer diagnoses and high breast cancer death rates for Black women in Indianapolis. In addition to being the director of CHEqI, Dr. Jasmine Gonzalvo was recently diagnosed with Stage 2 breast cancer and is hoping to shed light on the disparities other populations face.
